INFORMATION FOR INSPECTORS AND CERTIFIERS

Once business has resumed at Alert Level 2, the recheck 'stop clock' restarts. The clock stopped on Monday 23 March 2020 with the introduction of Alert Level 3, and the clock restarts on Thursday 14 May 2020 when New Zealand moves to Alert Level 2. The dates below are for your reference to assist you to calculate recheck periods.

ENTRY CERTIFICATION

The **21 business day** recheck period begins on Thursday 14 May 2020. The entry certifier should apply the 6-20 day requirements as shown in Table 1-10-1. Re-inspection procedures.

Note 1: The only exception to this requirement is if the vehicle has been held within the entry certifier's quarantine system.
