The information about me that the NZ Police may consider relevant to this Application and release to the Agency includes any conviction history, infringement/demerit reports, active investigations, charges and warrants to arrest, information received or obtained by NZ Police, any interaction I have had with NZ Police, even where I have not been charged, or charges are withdrawn, or if I have been acquitted (found not guilty) of a charge, or I have been discharged without conviction, and information subject to name suppression where that information is necessary for the purpose of the disclosure.

- If you are eligible under the Criminal Records (Clean Slate) Act 2004, your conviction history will not be released unless Section 19(3) of the Clean Slate Act applies to this request (exceptions to the clean slate regime).
- Information provided in this consent form may be used to update New Zealand Police records.
- You are entitled to a copy of the vetting result released to the Agency (to be provided by the Agency) and can seek a correction by contacting the Police.
- The Agency will securely dispose of this consent form, copies of identification documents and the vetting result within 12 months of receiving the result unless a longer retention period is required by legislation.
- You may withdraw this consent, prior to Police disclosure of the vetting result, by notifying the Agency.
